Our first event in 2008 raised over \$7,000 for the Start Making a Reader Today (SMART) Program and in 2009 we donated over \$10,000 to Junior Achievement.

This year we are excited and proud to announce we were awarded a \$10,000 Klamath County Tourism Grant to market and promote our event outside of Klamath County. Our 3rd Annual Summer Fun Run & Festival will be on July 10, 2010 outside at the Epicenter/Aftershock in Klamath Falls, Oregon.
